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Пособие предназначено для подготовки учащихся 7 классов общеобразовательных организаций к Всероссийской проверочной работе (ВПР) по английскому языку.

Сборник содержит 10 тренировочных вариантов письменной и устной частей ВПР. Письменная часть включает задания по аудированию, чтению, грамматике и лексике. Все задания снабжены ключами.

В устную часть входят задания на чтение вслух текста и описание фотографии с опорой на план. В конце книги даны критерии оценивания выполнения этих заданий, которые помогут составить представление о требованиях к полноте и правильности развёрнутого ответа.

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Предисловие

Данное пособие предлагает 10 вариантов тренировочных работ по английскому языку для подготовки учащихся 7-х классов к Всероссийской проверочной работе (ВПР), предназначенной для оценки уровня освоения обучающимися предметного содержания курса иностранных языков и выявления тех его элементов, которые вызывают наибольшие затруднения. Содержание и структура работ соответствует требованиям Федерального государственного образовательного стандарта основного общего образования (приказ Минобрнауки России от 17.12.2010 № 1897) с учётом Примерной основной образовательной программы основного общего образования по иностранному языку.

Каждый вариант тренировочной работы включает в себя шесть заданий и состоит из двух частей: письменной и устной. Письменная часть содержит задания по аудированию, чтению, грамматике и лексике. Устная — задания по чтению текста вслух и по говорению (монологическая речь). Подборка материалов соответствует предметному, лексическому и грамматическому содержанию курса английского языка, изучаемого в 7 классе, и в то же время учитывает разный уровень подготовки учащихся.

Сборник позволит учителю проводить различные виды работ как в ходе учебного процесса, так и для промежуточного контроля. Его также могут использовать учащиеся для самостоятельного развития и совершенствования речевых умений и навыков.

Инструкция по выполнению работы

На выполнение работы по английскому языку даётся 45 минут. Работа включает в себя 6 заданий.

При необходимости можно пользоваться черновиком. Записи в черновике проверяться и оцениваться не будут.
